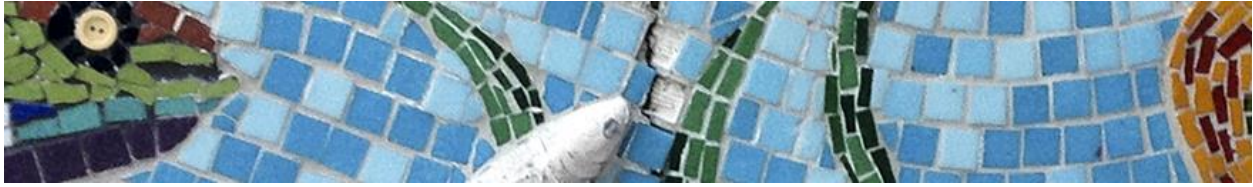
Photographer Clyde Butcher inspecting a film negative at his lightbox.
