Vista:

septic pumped and inspected, renewal filed with county

After approval: concrete pad, comfort station, eventual pole barn

Removed old concrete pads

Knocked down fry shed, wood shed and two story barn

A couple of pecky cypress boards removed from barn and saved

Idalia damage:

Refuge issued permit Suwannee refuge to move building that floated into refuge marsh north of Suwannee town, process documented by film crew

River trail closed

Shell mound road closed until dock rebuilt, can walk in. Dennis creek much debris

Atsena Otie trail boardwalk is gone

Fishbone creek compromised platform floated away ended up in tree

Shired island road closed, but signs torn down. Restroom closed

Lack of law enforcement personnel:

Daniel et al do not feel safe in Dixie county with all lawlessness

Next hunt season may need to be shortened

Other:

Daniel in woods masticating and spraying, contractors working in Dixie county. Clearing sides of roads should be good for pollinators.

Refuge budget has been spent down, spent last years money

USDA will be starting hog control project to control African swine fever. Will include trapping, on ground shooting perhaps helicopters. Should be outside of hunting season

Hydrologic restoration received word from FI trustee implementation group looking favorably to increase funding

As trailer stuff comes in it will be stored in refuge shed

October Seahorse open house drew 39 people, low attendance likely due to less people in Cedar Key post storm
