Trailer insurance Debbie M. insurance is required because although we could self-insure for comp and collision to the trailer which is only worth about \$4,000, the trailer could damage another vehicle which could be costly. Must transfer title to refuge and the refuge would handle insurance. All the tow drivers must take an 8 hour safety course and have an agreement for towing. Refuge vehicles may be used for towing or personal vehicles may be used but driver's personal insurance must be used for coverage.

- Trailer comp and collision insurance
 - The trailer is covered for liability under the policy of whatever vehicle is towing it and it remains covered even if the trailer comes unhitched from the vehicle according to Debbie's insurance broker, Bird Insurance Group.
 - Comp and Collision under Friends insurance since we do not have a vehicle:
 Liability \$2,409. Liability plus collision which includes theft \$2,509.
 - Comp and Collision under Debbie's insurance- \$114.86/yr. All claims then have to go through her, potentially raising her overall insurance rate.
 - If we transfer the trailer to the Refuge, who would then self-insure it for comp and collision:
 - Anyone who tows it must sign a volunteer agreement specifically for towing the trailer AND must pass the safe driver course even if you tow it with a personal vehicle.
 - If you tow it with a personal vehicle then the Refuge's liability insurance does not cover it.

Debbie M: insurance is required because although we could self-insure for comp and collision to the trailer which is only worth about \$4,000, the trailer could damage another vehicle which could be costly. Must transfer title to refuge and the refuge would handle insurance. All the tow drivers must take 8 hour safety course and have

agreement for towing. Refuge vehicles may be used for towing or personal vehicles may be used but driver's personal insurance must be used for coverage.
