

Gate 12
Lower Suwannee Refuge
Pine Flatwoods, Oak Scrub, Hammock, Cypress Strand

Trailhead: Gate 12 on Lower Suwannee Nature Drive, 8.3 miles from South Entrance; .9 miles from North Entrance.

Parking: On cleared right of way in any area that does not block gate

Length: 1.6 miles round trip

Loop: No

Handicap accessible: No

Conditions: Trail consists of old logging road that is kept mowed. Mostly unshaded.

Sights: Birds, wildflowers, butterflies, pine flatwoods, cypress strand, open areas, oak scrub and hammock.

Highlights: Easy walk through mixed habitats.

Connections: There is a spur to the left .12 miles from Gate 12 with a round trip of 1.4 miles. This spur goes through similar habitats with University of Florida insect study facilities near its end.
