| Highlights:             | Easy walk through longleaf pine habitat merging into riverine floodplain and then<br>ending at expansive view of Suwannee River. Take camp chairs and enjoy the<br>view on the small beach. An unusual concrete bat house is located near the trail as<br>you approach the river. |
| Connections:            | Across Nature Drive from Gate 14 is Gate 15 which goes out to CR 347 at Gate 3.<br>One option is to park at Gate 3 on CR 347 and hike to Suwannee River and back<br>on the combined trails. Total round trip: 2.4 miles.  |
